

Educational Pact of Joint Responsibility (synthesis of the School Regulation). General Rules

A school community is a place where human beings and future citizens are educated and built through learning and the acquisition of knowledge.

It is community of debate, research, social experience where everyone, with dignity and in a variety of roles, cooperates to guarantee the right to study, the development of human potentialities, the respect for interests and attitudes, the planning of remedial work when needed.

The school community builds its project and educational action on the valuable quality of the relationship among teacher-student-family and, while interacting with the wider civil and social community, contributes to the development of the student's personality through the acquisition of self esteem, sense of responsibility, independence of thought when formulating opinions and judgement.

Life in a school community is based on freedom of expression, thought, conscience, religion, mutual respect among all the people who are in it.

The Headmaster, the teachers and the staff – aware of the educational responsibilities of the school - commit to taking a responsible, impartial attitude towards all the people of the community. This attitude must be characterized by strong ideas of collaboration and professionalism in order to promote a behavior of responsible participation, always respecting the different roles.

The headteacher's duties

The Headteacher is the legal representative of the institution and he/she is responsible of the whole management. He/she respects the teachers' freedom of teaching which is also freedom of research and the methodological and teaching innovation. He/she coordinates and enhances human resources in order to promote the school educational offer; he/she organizes the school activity as he/she is the guarantor of the right of learning; he/she promotes the dialogue between the different components of the school community in order to permit everyone to play one's role in the best way. He/she ensures the respect for the law and a good performance of the school activity. He/she provides control and security in the school rooms.

The teachers' duties

They respect, in the process teaching/learning, the modality, time, rhythm, need of each student, according to his age and uniqueness. They guarantee the students an active and responsible participation in the school life through a positive relationship with the students themselves and families and strategies to prevent and modify behaviours which are inappropriate to the social context. They respect everyone's identity, culture, religion in a serene and active learning environment. They protect the right to privacy. They monitor the processes of the students' maturation through a daily observation of behaviours, and a prompt and transparent evaluation. They communicate the results to students and families. They know and respect the School Regulation and they are responsible for the surveillance of the students. They adapt language and clothing and any other expression to the place where they act.

The Staff's duties

They collaborate with teachers reporting inappropriate behaviours, critical and dangerous situations. They protect the right to privacy of families and students. They know and respect the school rules. They take part in the good run of the school, they take care of the students' watch. They adapt language, clothing and any other modality of expression to the place where they act.

The Students' duties

Students must attend lessons with regularity, including additional courses they have subscribed to, and they must fulfill established school tasks. Students must be punctual. They must know and respect the School Regulation.

Each student is responsible for the furnishings given to him or to the class and he will be asked to pay the school any damage and/or do activities for the whole community. Students cannot come to school with objects which are not related to school activities and they must not use the mobile phone at school. They must keep all the rooms cosy not deteriorating or devastating them.

During school activities students must have a dignified and civil behavior in order not to cause people or things any disturb, awkwardness, offense. They must adapt language, clothing and any other modality of expression to the school environment according to the rules of good manners and a civil life.

Each student must respect himself, the school staff, his classmates of all cultures and religions.

The Parents' duties

They partake in the educational path working together with the teachers and respecting the School Regulation. They help their children to fulfill school duties, checking day by day their school agenda and the copy-book used for any notice between the School and the family. They make sure that their children go to the remedial courses. They inform the School about any possible problem which can cause repercussions on the learning progress of the student. They promptly justify their children's absences and they must give the School reason if the students are late. They know the School project. They promptly intervene and work together with the teachers in case of lack of advancement or discipline. They must keep themselves constantly informed of the learning and disciplinary trend of their children in the days and meetings established by the school. They take part in the meetings established by the school. They are responsible for damages to people or things when their children have caused them. They share the educational tasks with the school always respecting the different roles.
